REAP Update

Because of the pandemic, REAP is serving more families than ever! We are still serving on a drive through basis. We route cars through the parking lot at St. Henry church and around the west side of the church. We are open on Thursdays from 9-11am. Having packed up boxes on Wednesdays we also get a pop-up of food from the greater Lansing food bank at about 8:30am. This food is usually dairy and produce but sometimes also has bread, meat and snacks loaded on pallets and trucked to us. We are fortunate that we also receive food donations from Target, Panera Bread and Sacred Heart church from both the grade and high school. We also receive food from other churches and of course, individuals. All food that is received must be weighed and put away. We also receive monetary contributions as we buy much of the food we give out. We can purchase food for pennies on the dollar from Lansing Food Bank but needed items are not always available, so we also order from Meijer warehouse at a discount.

We only ask simple questions of clients – family name, number of people in the family and an age breakdown. We never turn anyone away so if you or anyone you know is in need, come and receive! We have gone from serving 50-70 families a week to 80-90 a week. The Thursday of Veterans Day we served 109 families and expect even more on the 18th! Right now, Our Lady of Hope is collecting for baskets to give to our families that are on the Angel Tree so please give generously for them! December 3rd we will again be collecting for reap. we have a new food donation box made by Kim Geiger. If you wish to donate money, just put it in the collection in an envelope labeled REAP.
